

Brian Carnahan, Director of Program Compliance

Brian Carnahan has served since March 2006 as the Director of the Ohio Housing Finance Agency's (OHFA) Office of Program Compliance. He began working for OHFA in April 1999 as Special Projects Coordinator. In September 2003, Mr. Carnahan was named the Assistant Director of the OHFA Office of Program Compliance. Prior to assuming his role in Program Compliance, he was Project Administration Manager, responsible for helping Housing Development Assistance Program funding recipients with project implementation and related issues. In May 2008, Mr. Carnahan was invited to join the Housing Credit Certified Professional (HCCP) Board of Governors. He also serves on the Board of the Midwest Affordable Housing Management Association. Mr. Carnahan earned a Master of Business Administration from Franklin University, a Master of Arts in Geography from Kent State University, and completed a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and Geography at The Ohio State University. He holds the Specialist in Housing Credit Management, Assisted Housing Manager and Housing Development Finance Professional designations.
