**WHEREAS**, it is Ohio law to provide fair housing opportunities throughout Ohio regardless of race, gender, color, nationality, religion, military or family status, or disability; and

**WHEREAS**, April 11, 2022 marks the 54<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the passage of the U.S. Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, which enunciates a national policy for Fair Housing; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio is committed to the mission and intent of Congress to provide fair and equal housing opportunities for all; and

**WHEREAS**, the state of Ohio joins the federal government in educating local governments, community leaders, realty companies and housing associations on fair housing laws and policies to reduce the number of incidents of housing discrimination and Fair Housing law violations; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio joins the federal government in encouraging local governments to intensify their efforts to further the purpose of the federal Fair Housing Amendments Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Housing Finance Agency, the Ohio Department of Commerce, and the Ohio Department of Development continue to utilize federal and state resources to provide Ohioans with a safe, decent, and affordable place to call home.


